University School of the Lowcountry is a co-educational, non-sectarian, non-profit independent school with tax-exempt 501(c)(3) status. Currently offering grades 3-8, it is located in Mount Pleasant and serves the metro Charleston area. University School families come from across the Lowcountry: Charleston, Daniel Island, Folly Beach, Isle of Palms, Mount Pleasant, North Charleston, Sullivan's Island, and West Ashley.

On April 23, 2010, University School will hold its Annual Auction, and the proceeds will go to support University School's mission. USL receives no financial support from local, state or federal governments, and, like most successful independent schools, relies on annual giving to cover operating expenses.

University School of the Lowcountry aspires to be an uplifting presence in our community. Through many forms of service, education, and outreach, USL develops leaders who have first-hand knowledge of the resources in and challenges facing our community and world. USL maintains relationships with Windwood Farm home for boys, Lowcountry Food Bank, area homeschool families, and others. Students learn Latin, Spanish, and Mandarin, and weekly field learning experiences enable them to acquire knowledge and skills experientially from area experts. This includes extensive study of the ethnic and religious diversity that the Lowcountry features. USL also fills a community need for a school designed for high-achieving students, and it operates in a manner that makes its programs available to many. For example, USL's prudent financial model has enabled us to keep the same tuition for three straight years, including 2009-2010. Furthermore, approximately 20% of the student population receives financial assistance.

We are asking local businesses to donate goods and services to be auctioned off that evening. All interested businesses, foundations, families and individuals are invited to contribute through their time, their talents and their donations. The funds raised from the auction will be used to help University School realize the promise of its mission. All supporters of the USL community are invited to join us for the End of Year Celebration on Monday, May 3.
