

## Opening for the 2025-2026 School Year Part-Time Art Teacher (5 hours, 1 day per week – 11:30-4:30)

University School of the Lowcountry is seeking an experienced, positive, and engaging trained mental health professional to serve as the School Counselor for grades 3-12 (approximately 80-85 students). Founded in 2007 and located in Mount Pleasant and serving the metro Charleston area, University School of the Lowcountry (<a href="www.uslowcountry.org">www.uslowcountry.org</a>) (USL) is a co-educational, non-sectarian, non-profit independent school with tax-exempt 501(c)(3) status geared to high-achieving students. USL's curriculum is designed to engage our students at an advanced level. Offering grades 3-12, University School seeks to develop self-confident, passionate, and empathetic learners who will make a positive difference in the world.

We are seeking an innovative, energetic and positive art teacher. This is a part-time position, and the job entails the following:

- (1) giving art instruction for students in grades 3-5
- (2) overseeing our weekly after-school Art Club.

Art instruction involves two classes of 10-15 students, and each class is approximately 45-55 minutes. It includes supporting art projects in History/English/Global Languages classes, creating art projects, and overseeing the creation of special schoolwide art projects. Art Club runs from 3:15-4:10 and is open to the entire student body, and it usually has 10-15 participants each week.

The day set for this is currently Thursdays, but we could potentially change if this works best for the ideal candidate.

Our three prior Art teachers, two who served in this role for 5+ years, are available for consultation and guidance. One relocated to California, and the other retired. The third has taken on administrative responsibilities in our Intermediate School.

The ideal candidate will have demonstrated use of a variety of teaching methods in the arts and have experience working with young students.
